Workers' Compensation Commission

We are operating under and subject to the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Act.

In case of accidental injury or death to an employee, the injured employee or someone acting in his or her name should give immediate notice to the employer or general authorized agent. Failure to give such immediate notice may be the cause of serious delay in the payment of compensation to the injured employee or his or her dependents and may result in failure to receive any compensation benefits under the law.

Workers' Compensation:

1. Pays 100% of your medical bills or some other expenses.
2. Compensates you for lost wages or salary, limited to the maximum amount by law, if you are unable to work for more than seven (7) calendar days.

- What you should do:**
1. Notify your employer at once. You cannot receive benefits unless your employer knows you are injured.
 2. Tell the doctor your employer sends you or that you are covered by workers' compensation.
